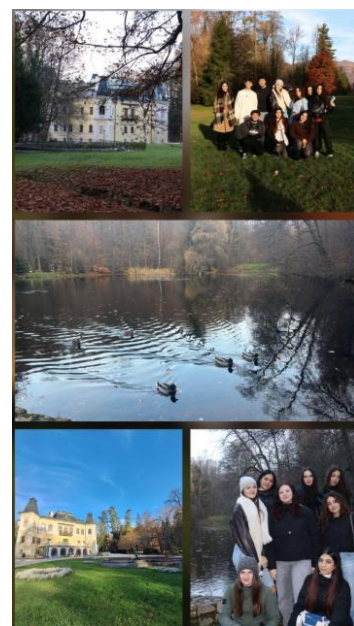


STUDENT MOBILITY TO ROŽŇAVA, SLOVAKIA

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss issues related to democracy, intercultural communication, education, human rights and sustainability. The students had the opportunity to learn about these topics in relation to the history of the city we visited and of Slovakia in general, through their participation in interactive workshops where they were given the chance to collaborate in international groups with Italian and Slovak students and to collaboratively create posters and board games concerning the above-mentioned topics. At the same time, our students participated in educational excursions to places that highlight the environmental, cultural and



historical identity of the country. They also experienced the daily life of the partner school by attending physics, computer and biology courses, thus learning how the education system works in the host country.

We also prepared impact surveys that were completed by participating teachers and students from both countries focusing on their expectations before mobility, their experiences during it, and their final reflections after its end.
